HOW TO MAKE SCULPTURE WITH PEOPLE

6TH SEP 10AM -4:30PM
MORECAMBE LIBRARY

Hosted by Artist Ellie Barrett, this symposium hosts a series of presentations and interventions from artists, researchers and curators each exploring possibilities for bringing public groups into sculpture making, exploring how and why we might make artworks with other people.

The symposium marks the final part of a longer project, funded by Arts Council England, exploring co-production as a strategy for sculpture making. All Kinds of Hands, an exhibition at the Storey, Lancaster, was an earlier phase in this project and presents a starting point to expand on themes and topics related to co-produced sculpture.

In the second session you will then be shown how to use the riso printer to print your zine in four colours.
